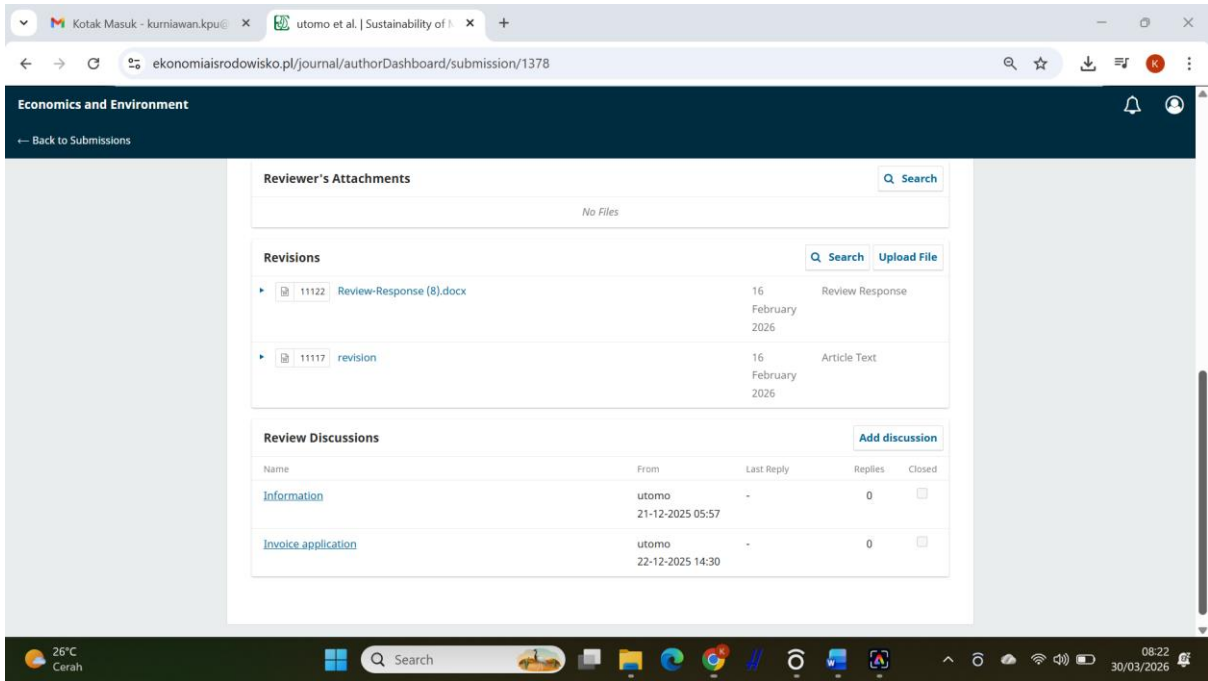

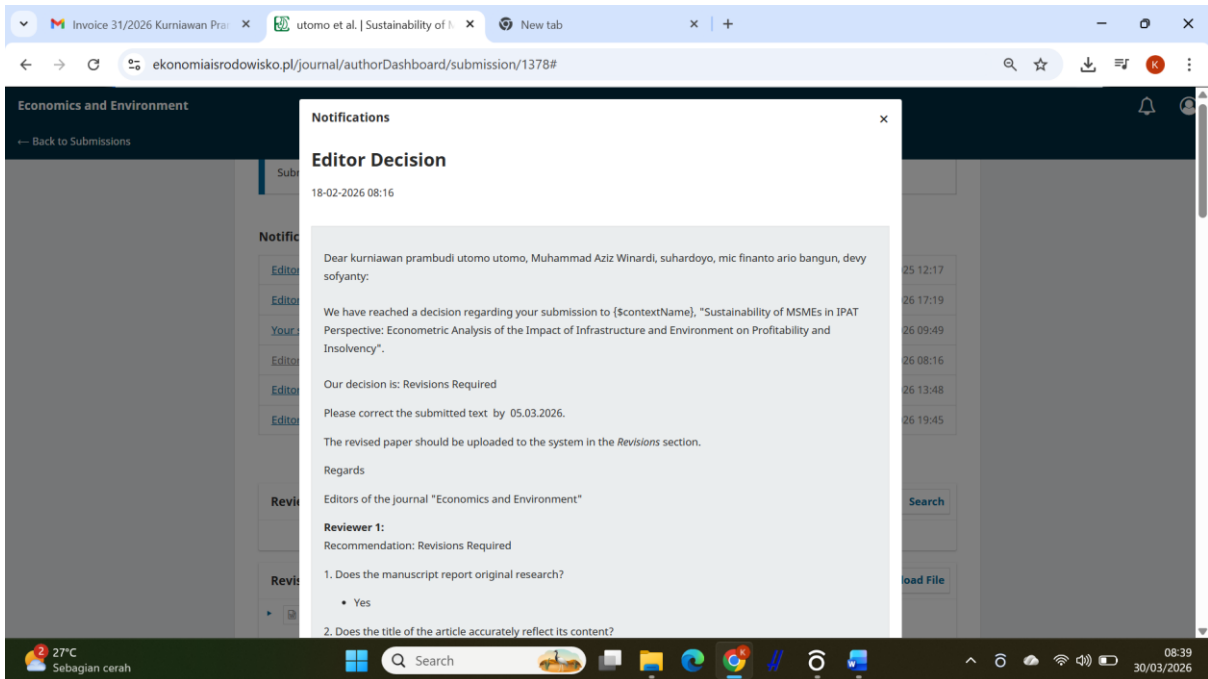

The reviewer's feedback is as follows: "The reviewed paper addresses an interesting and quite original (especially for a Polish readers) topic. However, it requires significant refinement to meet the high standards of the prestigious Journal 'Economics & Environment.' Below, I propose a few corrections that will improve its current version: - the abbreviation Ibu Kota Nusantara is not explained in the 'Abstract' (the explanation appears only in the introduction); - the title of the paper identifies MSMEs from the Indonesian capital city as the subject of the study. However, as it turns out later in the paper, not a single medium-sized enterprise was included in the research sample. This necessitates a change to the paper's title, which, in its current form, is misleading to the reader; - 'Introduction' is a single, excessively long paragraph, lacking the main purpose of the study, the research hypothesis, or the method used (which appear only in the section 'Research methods and sampling'). I suggest breaking it into shorter paragraphs, clearly stating the purpose and hypothesis (even in short way); - Author(s) do(es) not clearly demonstrate the research gap that this study aims to fill (e.g. into the 'Introduction' or next section). A stronger emphasis on this issue (along with references to the current state of research) seems necessary; - lack of literature references in the Slovin formula; - very cursory description of the 'Research methods and sampling' section - the Author(s) only indicate(s) that 'The research uses an econometric approach to determine the factors that influence MSMEs (...)' A more detailed description of the method used (SEM) would have been much more appropriate; - 'Discussion' does not present a typical comparison of the obtained research results to the current state of research (e.g., conducted in other locations). It would be valuable to more thoroughly discuss the researchers' previous achievements in this area and compare them with our own results; - short and incomplete 'Conclusion' section; it fails to address practical implications or study limitations, and the summary of the results is very cursory, imprecise; - In many places in the text there are unnecessary spaces and typos - I suggest you carefully review the text once again, solely from this perspective: - a missing title and abstract in Polish (at the end of the text), which are mandatory elements in the journal 'Economics & Environment'." The reviewer concludes with: "After making these corrections, please submit the revised version of the paper for further review." 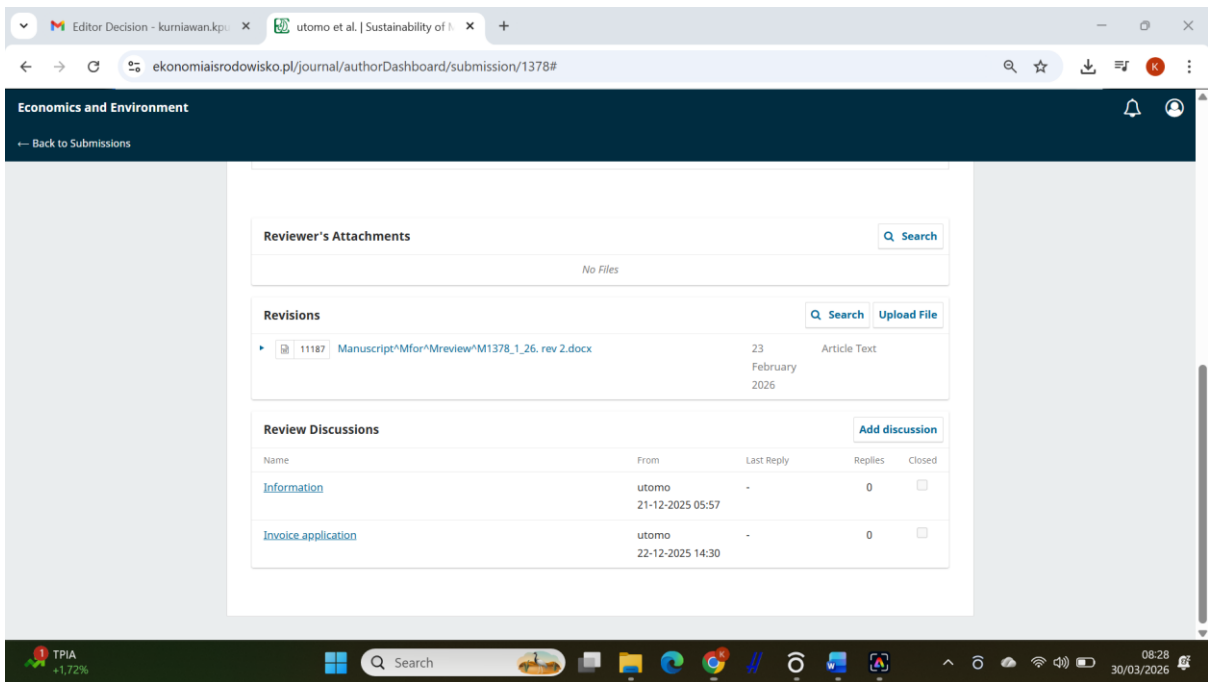

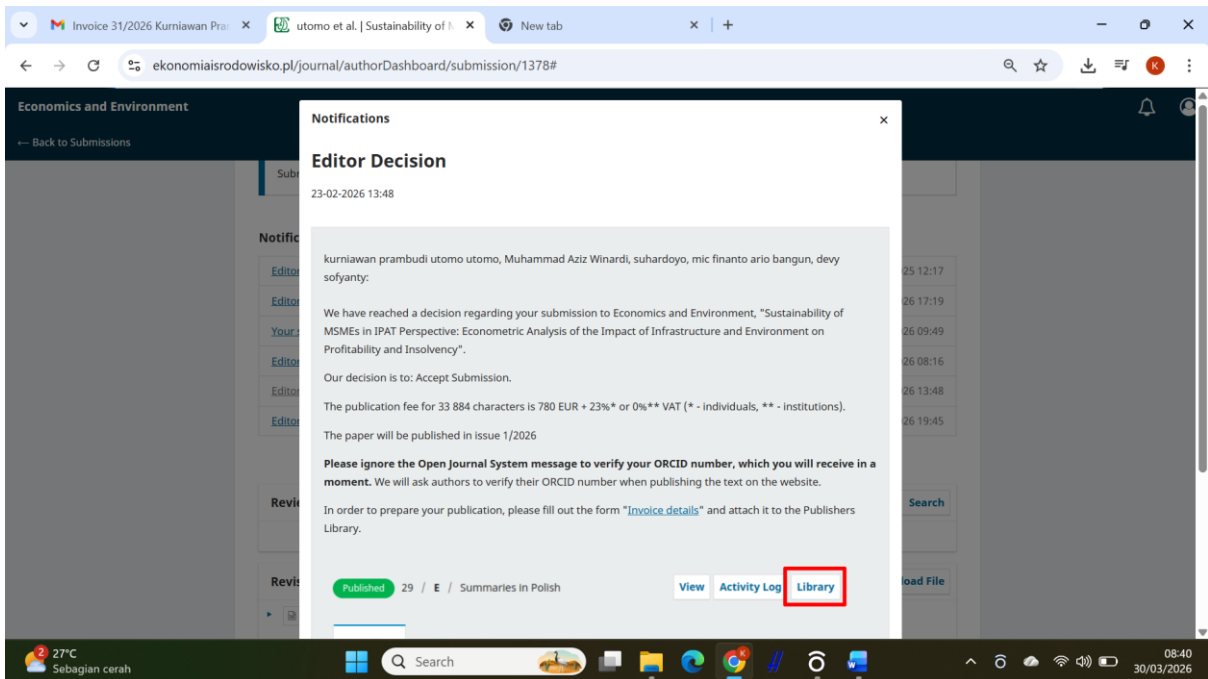
